ENTRY: Athletes may register either online or on-site. Please be aware that on-site registration will include a \$10.00 service charge. **NO REFUNDS** for failure to compete. Participants **MUST** present proof of current USA Wrestling Membership Card at registration and weigh-ins. Athletes can print current USAW Membership card by accessing your respective "**PROFILE**" on www.usawmembership.com.

ONLINE REGISTRATION: Online registration is available at www.trackwrestling.com. Deadline for online registration is 5:00 PM (MST), Wednesday, October 26, 2011. Entry fee for participants registering online with credit card is \$40.00 per athlete. Official Waiver forms will be completed during ONLINE registration process.

ON-SITE REGISTRATION: Those who chose to register on-site will pay \$40.00 plus \$10.00 service fee (\$50.00 total). **OFFICIAL WAIVER and REGISTRATION FORMS** can be printed at www.themat.com/events/Release_Waiver.pdf

INDIVIDUAL AWARDS: The champion of the men's freestyle and Greco-Roman division will be awarded \$1,000 (U.S. and/or foreign athletes). The champion of the women's division will be awarded \$750 (U.S. and/or foreign athletes). Men's freestyle and Greco-Roman: 2nd=\$500; 3rd=\$250 (U.S. Citizens ONLY) and Women: 2nd=\$250 (U.S. Citizens ONLY). Foreign athletes are eligible for 1st place prize money only. Awards will be given to the Outstanding Wrestler in each division.

TEAM AWARDS: Attractive awards to the top two placers in each division. USA Wrestling sanctioned clubs are eligible to enter. Registration must take place prior to the start of competition. Points are scored 6,5,4,3,2,1 for the top six place winners at each weight class.

RULES: The current rules of FILA will govern the event and the competition (except bracketing procedures).

UNIFORMS: Red and blue **high-cut** singlet's, or red/blue **high-cut** reversible singlet with under briefs required. For the women's division, a collegiate or women's singlet is required and a sleeveless sport top is to be worn under the singlet (no t-shirts).

BRACKETING & PAIRING: Double-elimination, straight-line bracketing to 3rd place. All weight classes will be wrestled to completion in one day. There will be a blind computer draw after initial weigh-in.

COACHING: All USA Wrestling Coaches Membership Cards **MUST** be attained prior to the event, due to mandatory background checking. For Coach's Membership cards go to www.themat.com, click on "Become a Member". Please note USA Wrestling's membership year begins on Sept 1st.

MEDICAL INFORMATION: Athletes must be prepared and must submit to a skin disease screening prior to weigh-in. The chief medical officer has full authority without appeal in determining the eligibility of an athlete to compete. In the event of injury or illness, no contestant will be permitted to continue the competition without approval of the Chief Medical Officer, whose decision is final and not subject to appeal.

WEIGH-INS: All wrestlers must be dressed in a FILA approved, High-Cut competition singlet for weigh-ins. No weight allowance is given for the singlet. All weigh-ins will be conducted in kilograms. There will be a two (2) kg weight allowance given at weigh-ins. 1KG = 2.2046 lbs.

OLYMPIC TEAM TRIALS QUALIFIER: Wrestlers, who meet the U.S. citizenship requirements necessary for representing the USA in the World Championships and are the Champion of the 2011 Sunkist Kids International Open, qualify for the 2012 Olympic Team Trials.

ELIGIBILITY: All contestants & coaches must present a current USA Wrestling Membership Card. Coaches must be a minimum of bronze certified. Athlete Membership cards should be acquired at www.themat.com. Click on "BECOME A MEMBER" Secondary sports accident insurance is provided as a benefit of membership. No pre-qualification required. Men & Women: Athletes born in 1991 or before are eligible. * However, **1992-1993 – Men** and **1992-1994 - Women** may compete with a written statement from a medical professional, on his/her printed stationary, attesting that the athlete is of sufficient physical and emotional maturity to participate at this level.
